Between 1974 - 1988, Jean's creative writing / producing career got underway in Dallas, Texas. He twice won the International Broadcasting Award for creativity in Radio Comedy Advertising. His creative services agency worked for major production companies on projects for major brands including 7-Eleven, McDonalds, Coca-Cola, American Airlines. Projects included "industrial theater" productions the most notable of which was the Coca-Cola Centennial Bottler's Meeting which had a production budget of more than \$1-million. Jean has also sold treatments for television shows and optioned screenplays. 1988 - 1991, Jean move to England where his agent in London secured him writing projects for major U.K. companies.

While in England, he added interpersonal communications skills to his mass communications skills. He earned a certificate in Organizational Development at the Centre For Social Development at Emerson College. Upon his return in 1991, Jean has been a "change" and conflict resolution consultant for socially progressive organizations. He is a peace and social-justice activist and has taught self-development courses in maximum security prisons in Pennsylvania and Michigan.
